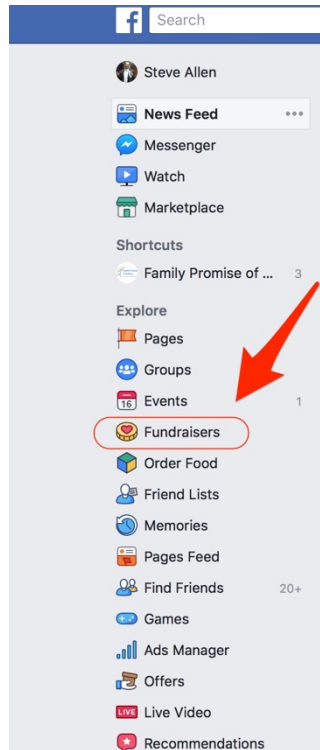


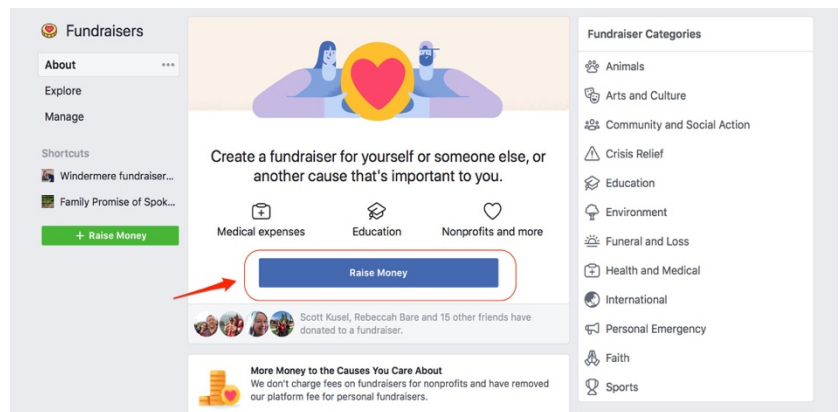
Fundraisers for Nonprofits

To create a fundraiser for Family Promise of Spokane, follow these steps:

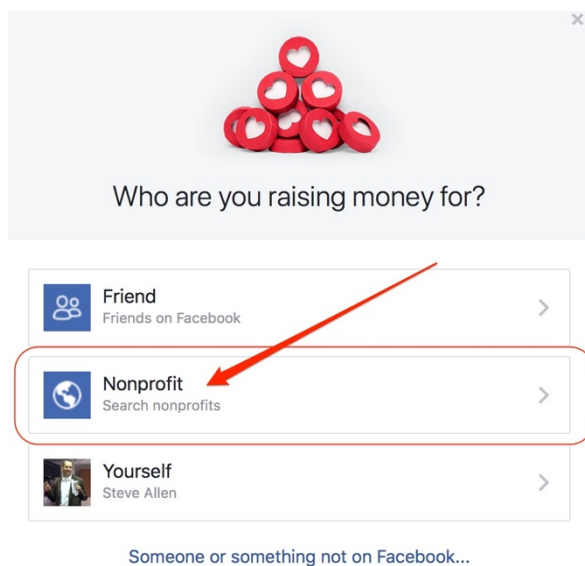


1. Click **Fundraisers** in the left menu of your News Feed.
